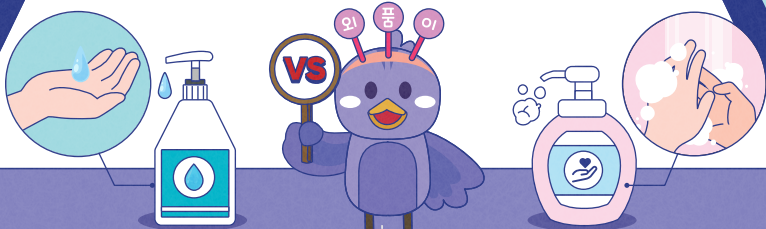

Hand sanitizers, which disinfect your skin, are quasi-drugs reported to and approved by the Ministry of Food and Drug Safety. Check for approved (reported) hand sanitizers on the Drug Safety Land website.

DAILY ESSENTIALS



1. Remember to check



Check 'quasi-drug' (의약외품) on label



Check 'Uses' (효능·효과) on back of product

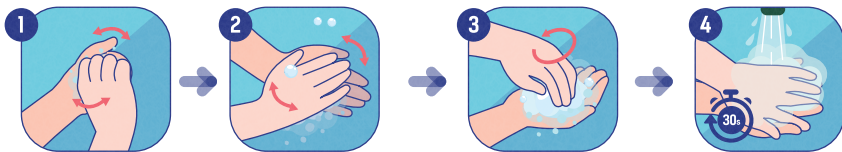


Check 'Active ingredient' (유효성분) on back of product (Alcohol, Isopropanol etc.)

2. Properly washing your hands and using hand sanitizers



washing your hands is a must to prevent infectious diseases!
Diseases can be effectively prevented by washing your hands.



Apply a sufficient amount to cover both hands, and rub the back of the fingers to the opposing palm.

Rub your **palms together**.

Rub clasped fingers of one hand in the palm of the other hand to **keep the area below the fingernails clean**.

Rinse in running water for **at least 30 seconds**.

Use a hand sanitizer if you cannot wash your hands! Do so only if washing your hands is difficult. Remember that washing your hands comes first!



Apply a **suitable amount** (about the size of a 500 won coin).

Thoroughly rub the back of your hands, palms, and below the fingernails.

Dry for **about 30 seconds!**

3. Precautions related to hand sanitizers



✔ Keep out of reach of children

Store hand sanitizers at room temperature (1-30°C) and in areas out of reach of children. Guardians must exercise caution to prevent accidents involving children (consumption, inhalation, etc.).



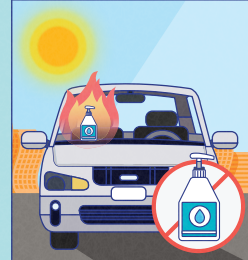
✔ Be careful not to let any hand sanitizer enter your eyes

Hand sanitizers can cause damage to the cornea if they come into contact with your eyes. If any amount gets in your eyes, wash several times with water, apply an ice pack, and visit a medical professional.



✔ Use on hands only

Avoid using on eyes, ears, mouth, broad areas of the body, and damaged skin as doing so may cause irritation. Consult a medical professional and or pharmacist if your skin becomes red or itchy after use.



✔ Do not store for long periods in vehicles in hot weather

Hand sanitizers high in ethanol content may cause fires when **temperatures rise in vehicles**.



✔ Be careful of fires and burns

Wait at least 30 seconds after applying on your hands before using open flames.
